Description

The "bambolina" is an element used in chandeliers of the Muranese tradition. Spirally arranged and internally lit by halogen light bulbs, they form a bright swirl which adorns the setting with designs and shadows thanks to the typical glass working called "a balotón" (giving a cross-relief effect on glass).

The chromed fixture is equipped with low-voltage halogen down lights and is also available in rectangular form with the elements arranged linearly.

Available colors: Gold, Cognac or Crystal.
