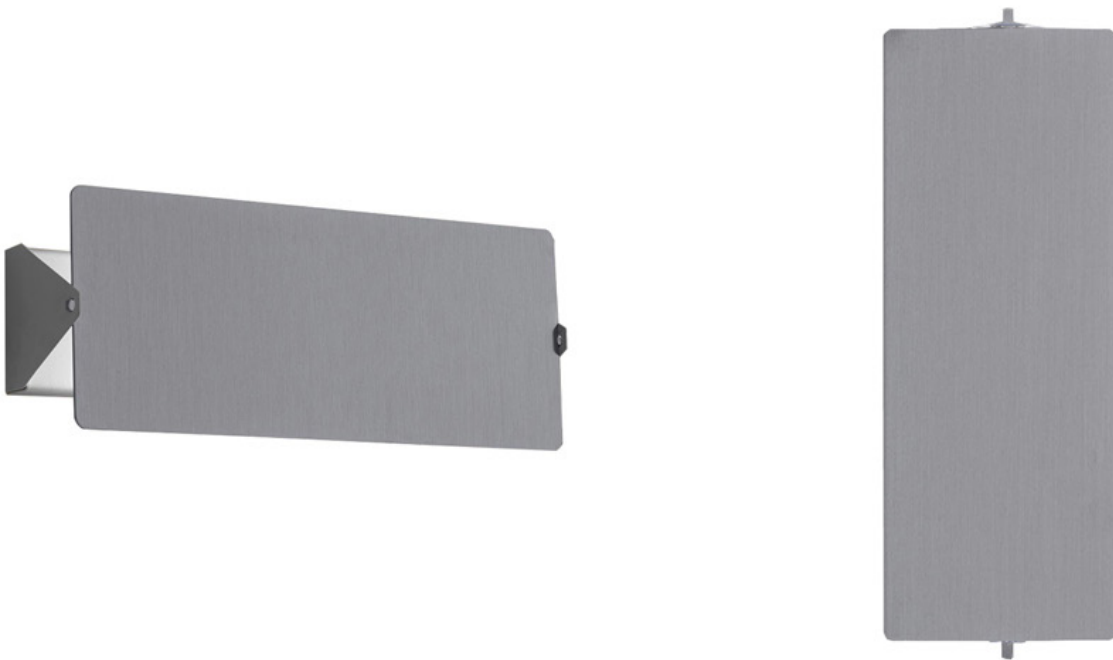


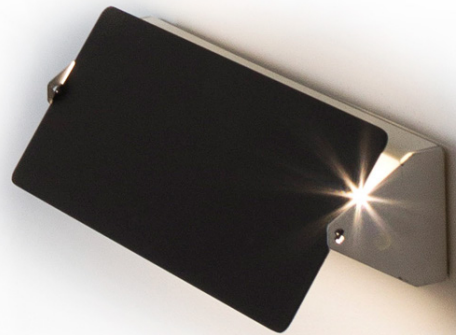
# Applique à Volet Pivotant Double

## *Description*

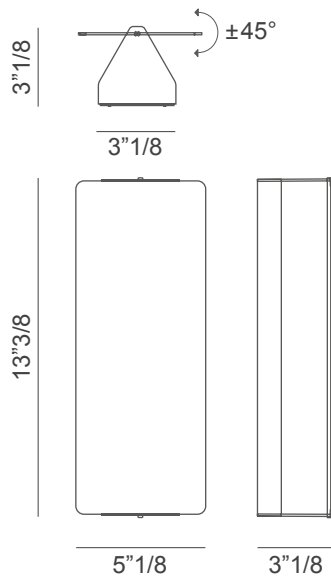
Wall lamps designed in 1962 by Charlotte Perriand for her mountain chalet in Méribel in the French Alps. Aluminum adjustable volet and white metal structure. Indirect light output towards the wall and orientable flood beam. The cover plate is always included. Both versions are ADA compliant and the E12 version is also UL listed. Made in Italy.



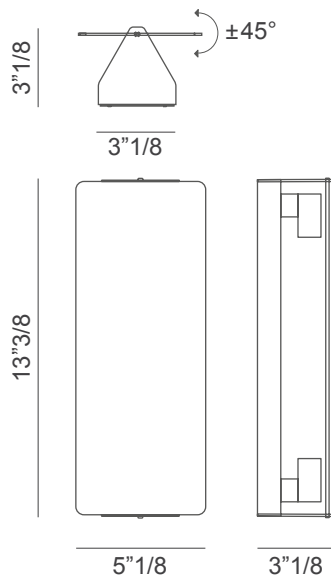
