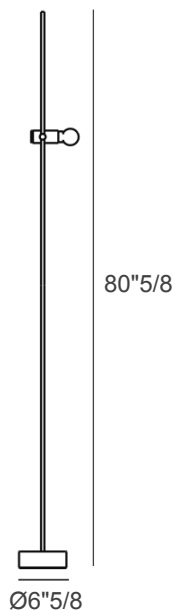
Created in 1954 by Tito Agnoli for Oluce, the Agnoli lamp is one of the most historic and iconic pieces in the brand's catalogue. A true precursor of minimalism, it introduced a radically modern approach by using the innovative Cornalux light bulb, mounted on a sliding mechanism along a slender stem, allowing the light to be directed with extreme precision. The lamp's travertine base adds a touch of refined elegance, balancing the purity of its design with the natural richness of stone. In this timeless creation, simplicity and functionality are elevated into elements of pure poetry.

Agnoli stands as a masterpiece of luxury lighting design, embodying the harmony between designer lights, architectural minimalism, and high-end light fixtures that continue to influence contemporary lighting fixtures today. Made in Italy.
