Description

Eva, designed by Francesca Borelli, is a sophisticated table lamp born from the intimate dialogue between light, shape and movement. Conceived as an investigation of opposites—hollow and solid, light and dark—it translates theory into a luxury design object where interaction becomes essential. The relationship between user and lamp introduces a playful, surprising dimension, transforming light into an ever-changing experience. Crafted entirely in metal, the lamp features a spherical body containing the LED source, supported by a slim cylindrical base. A surface nearly completes the sphere, closing it as if it were whole again, with the exception of a luminous circular opening—an elegant spiral of light that recalls the mystery of an eclipse.

By sliding this circular surface inwards or outwards, different intensities of light are revealed, creating intimate, refined atmospheres. In doing so, the lamp unveils delicate glimpses of the fine gold-leaf interior, whose subtle radiance enriches the design with exclusive allure.

Eva is a modern, poetic, and timeless lamp, a perfect balance of geometry, movement and light, evoking celestial phenomena with aristocratic elegance. Made in Italy.
