Description

Designed by Vico Magistretti in 1977, the Lyndon lamp has been revisited in three refined models — floor, table, and wall — conceived for elegant outdoor environments. The timeless design of the candelabra structure remains unchanged: a sleek metal stem frames four transparent polycarbonate spheres, which merge into a single luminous globe in the table and wall versions.

An expression of Magistretti's essential and modern design language, Lyndon is presented as a high-end piece in three exclusive versions: the original floor-standing and wall models, together with a newly introduced luxury table version. Made in Italy.

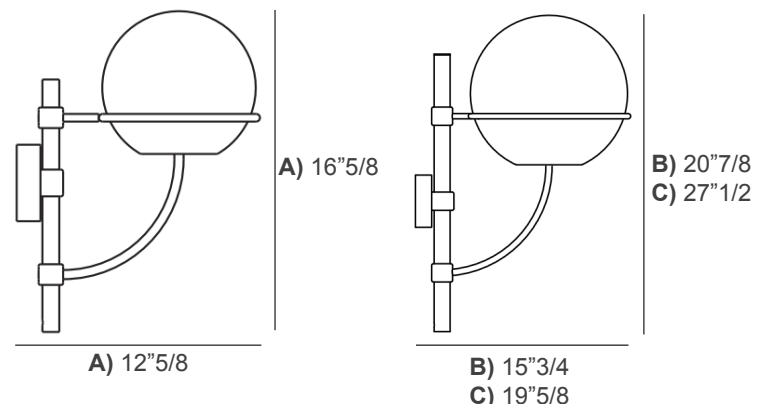
